<p>Description of activity (step-by-step)</p> <p>Address the trainer directly.</p>	<p>This Project-based learning encourages students to actively engage with real-world issues and challenges as part of their learning process.</p> <p>Project-based learning has been chosen as the methodology because it develops critical thinking, cooperation and practical research skills.</p> <p>This unit includes 10 project-based learning –prompts that give an opportunity for learners to explore social sustainability in a variety of contexts. The learners may approach these prompts individually or in groups.</p> <p>Through these prompts learners may apply the knowledge they have accumulated throughout the Social Sustainability Curriculum, and deepen their understanding of the principles of social sustainability in action.</p> <p>The teacher can choose one prompt from the 10 prompts, or ask the learners to choose a prompt of their choosing.</p> <p>The 10 prompts include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● PBL 1: Community Impact Assessment ● PBL 2: Diversity and Inclusion Campaign ● PBL 3: Supply Chain Ethics Analysis ● PBL 4: Social Entrepreneurship Venture ● PBL 5: Employee Well-Being Programme ● PBL 6: Fair-Trade Awareness Campaign ● PBL 7: Urban Renewal and Community Development ● PBL 8: Ethical Consumerism Guide ● PBL 9: Green Workplace Certification ● PBL 10: Civic Engagement Initiative <p>Before engaging on these prompts, the teachers should make sure the learners are familiar with the concepts of “benchmarking”, “reporting”, “market analysis” and “fair-trade”.</p> <p>The teacher is also instructed to utilize the project’s Social Impact Assessment Guide for further guidance on impact assessment and reporting.</p>
